PROCEDURE

SUBMIT NECESSARY INFORMATION

- Submit a purchase order for the custom design at the quoted price.
- Attach a filled out copy of the appropriate fixture dimension sheet.
- Attach a fixture manufacturer's data sheet if available.
- Describe any special requirements like light distribution, air flow, etc.
- Sometimes, though infrequently, the custom design staff will require that a fixture be sent in.

TEST AND APPROVE SAMPLE

- A sample will be constructed and sent for approval.
- Review sample and describe any changes needed with the custom design staff.
- If necessary, another sample will be sent for approval.
- When approved, submit quantity order.

POLICIES

- A purchase order must be submitted for all custom designs.
- A design fee of \$50 will be applied to all custom design orders. This fee will be credited in full upon receipt of a purchase order for a minimum of 50 of the customized designed parts.
- Attach a fixture manufacturer's data sheet if available.
- Reflect-A-Light,™ Inc. will not accept returns of custom designed products.
